**DESCRIPTION:**

This course is designed to provide emergency response personnel the information and skills necessary to operate safely and effectively at incidents involving the collapse or failure of structures. The course meets the requirements of NFPA 1670, “*Standard on Operations and Training for Technical Rescue Incidents*”, and NFPA 1006, “*Professional Qualifications for Structural Collapse Technician Level*.”

Performance of all required practical skills are necessary to receive certification; start and end times are for reference only

**Topics of instruction include:**

- Building Construction Types and Characteristics
- Collapse Assessment and Evaluation
- Vertical and Horizontal Shoring Systems
- Raker Shoring Systems
- Search Equipment Techniques and Operations

**Students are required to provide helmets, gloves, steel toe boots, and safety glasses  
Knee and elbow pads, headlamps and/or flashlights are recommended  
Personal equipment must be NFPA and ANSI compliant.
